



### Blessed Virgin Mary: an exemplar of service

### The Circle of Love - celebrating love in the family

Proverbs 23-22 says "Listen to your father who gave you life & do not despise your mother when she is old." I have been blessed throughout my life whether it be my maternal home or my husband's home. I've always received a lot of love & support. Ronnie & my marriage always consists of 3 couples: Ron's parents, my parents & us. My parents-in-law have been staying with us on & off. My parents live close by to our Home (now they've shifted to Mangalore). Earlier even for a normal weekend, we would have a mini get-together. Our boys have received affection from both their grandparents & extended family which makes me feel really fortunate. In current times where cousins and extended family are like unicorns, they've never felt alone as there is always someone at home.

Having both parents by my side is a good feeling because the child in me is kept alive. Every time I leave my house I am reminded about carrying an umbrella. My water bottle is placed near the scooter key which ensures that I'll never be thirsty on my walks. In case I am late from work I know there's a person waiting for me at home who won't eat unless I arrive, so I need to inform my mummy about what time I'll be home. Every time my parents call they remind me to take care of the kids & my health. I joke with them that I am now a grown woman but my father reminds me I'm still his 'Baiya'. It feels nice to have a pet name, especially from a parent. My mum & I can chat for hours together that too every day, it's just conversations about what is happening in each other's lives. Life is worth living because I know someone cares.

Staying with elders is a great blessing as it taught our boys to share, care & to be accommodating too. In case there's only one packet of chips it would be shared with all 6 people even if that meant that the boys received just one chip or two, it didn't bother them because sharing is what brought joy to them. My Papa died last year but when he was

with us he would remind the kids to study & he wouldn't eat until he would watch the boys eat. He loved to receive his medicines from his grandkids, he would ask the boys to give him his medicines or water or anything else he needed. Papa wouldn't sleep until we said our family rosary & now mummy is continuing that tradition. Family prayers are a must when there are elders at home, they ensure discipline.

All this being said doesn't mean it has been easier for any of us, it has been a journey of misunderstanding, quarrels, and anger but it also has been a journey of love, understanding and forgiveness. We've made a conscious decision to love one another & accept each other for who we are. Family is all about letting go of all bad memories & cherishing the good ones. The feeling that I don't need anyone will only lead us to being isolated. Right now, I'm playing both roles - of a mother to my boys and on the other hand a Daughter to my parents and parents-in-law. Interdependence creates a bond in a Family. This Circle Of Love that encompasses grandparents, parents and children ensures that we're loved immensely & deeply. And this Circle Of Love - is complete when we all cling on to a very Important Family member – Jesus.

### Prison Ministry India (Mumbai unit) - Called to Serve

Jesus said in Matthew 25:36, "I was in prison and you visited me".



Prison Ministry is a unique ministry loved by Jesus. It is a blessed ministry where volunteers are called to be ambassadors of compassion, to be a comfort to the lost sheep and to continue the mission of Jesus to seek and serve those in prison. It is God's special call to each one of us to be a blessing to the countless unfortunate ones behind bars. It is a Biblical ministry. It does not need any degree or qualification. You only need a heart of love – sacrificial love, selfless love – the love Jesus showed on the cross. If I am filled with love, I can give love and be one with the suffering and sorrow of prisoners. "Be a love bomb, let it explode, not to kill, but to heal the broken hearts."

Prison Ministry India (PMI) is an organization recognized by the Catholic Bishops Conference of India (CBCI) to reach out to our brothers and sisters who are in prison. Prison is a storehouse of pain and suffering. The inmates experience deprivation of freedom and isolation from their loved ones. They suffer psychologically, emotionally and spiritually and are in urgent need of care and support.

The Mumbai Unit of Prison Ministry India (PMM), works in five jails including Arthur Road, Byculla, Thane, Kalyan and Taloja and Jesus is waiting a also in a children's Home at Dongri, "Truly I tell you, Bhiwandi, Mankhurd and Matunga. The volunteers of PMM strive to reach out to these volunteers of PMM strive to reach out to these captives and bring them inner freedom – freedom from fear, guilt, shame and blame

Prison Ministry is a unique ministry loved by Jesus. It is a blessed ministry where volunteers are called to be ambassadors of compassion, to be a comfort to the lost sheep and to continue the mission of Jesus to seek and serve those in prison. It is God's special that grip their lives. We help them to regain their identity and give them a sense of dignity while they are still behind bars. In the unit of Dongri, under the dynamic leadership of our Director Fr. Glasten Gonsalves, our volunteers work with children below the age of 18 years.

We have a number of Prison Ministry volunteers from our parish St. Joseph Mira Road, who regularly visit the Children's Observation Home for boys and girls at Dongri, Arthur Road Jail and Byculla Jail. They are Lili, Fay, Antoneta, Audrey, Mary, Philomena, Grace, Dennis, Francis, Trevor, Arnold and Prof. Alex. We conduct regular classes to teach the children academic subjects, beautician, etiquette, sports, computer, music, arts and crafts and culinary skills which will empower them to face the outside world. Health camps like dental, hearing, and gynaecology are conducted for the children. Important days like Children's Day, Diwali, Christmas etc. are celebrated by the volunteers.

Do join this ministry as a volunteer and help us in spreading the message of Jesus "We love you and we want you to change". In the eyes of Jesus, every man, woman or child in the dark cells of prisons is a child of God, nothing else. Jesus is waiting for their return. Mathew 25:40 "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me".

### **Priesthood: A Life Dedicated To Serve God And His People**

You are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, so that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Peter 2:9)

On 4° August, we remember St. John Marie Vianney and in his honour we celebrate the following Sunday as 'Vianney Sunday' as we thank God and pray for all the priests in the world. We honour these men who have come from our own families and have dedicated their lives to Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church through the Sacrament of the Holy Orders. We frequently experience their care and concern for all of us as they hear our confessions, absolve our sins, anoint the sick and most importantly in celebration of the Holy Eucharist. When you consider these sacraments, they offer a powerful testament to the meaning of the Priesthood.

Everyone sees the Priest, and through him, they wish to catch a glimpse of the Lord!

We, the parishioners of St. Joseph Church Mira Road is blessed to have seven Carmelite Priests serving the parish. These Carmelite Priests follow the Role Model of Elijah and Mary. As humans we are not perfect, so are Priests, who come from among us to dedicate their lives to serving God's people. We often help our family members when they falter but many times when it comes to priests we don't hesitate to talk ill or criticize or judge them. As we constantly pray for the well-being of our

family members, we do have the responsibility to pray for the Priests and be with them to support them in their shortcomings.

He isn't there just to administer Sacraments but to make God's presence felt among us. He is there to walk with us on our journey. 



### Chicken Manchurian

### **Ingredients:**

1 kg boneless chicken

1/2 cup corn flour

2 eggs

1 inch piece of ginger

1 whole garlic pod

6 green chilies

a bunch of coriander

3 maggie cubes (make a stock using boiling water)

3 tbsp of dark soya sauce

1/2 tsp sugar

1/2 tsp pepper powder

5 green chilies

### -: Method:-

Take the eggs and corn flour and make a smooth batter. Cut the chicken into pieces. Mix it well with the batter and deep fry till golden brown. In another vessel, heat oil and put the finely chopped ginger, garlic and green chilies and shallow fry them. Add soya sauce, sugar, pepper powder. Add the fried chicken and stir well. Next, add the chicken stock. In a cup, take 2 tbsp of corn flour and little water to make a thick paste. Add this to the chicken mixture. Finally add the slit green chilies and coriander for garnish.
